#### **BAD GIG**

Booking tickets for West End shows is not very easy. I'm not a fan of ATG applying for their access scheme and having to prove Wendy has a learning disability felt super-stressful! You have to send proof like a PIP letter or a note from the doctor. I didn't like sending personal information about my Gigbuddy to a theatre company! After all that, we could still only afford to book tickets right at the back of the theatre.

physical evidence of disability to get a carer ticket.
