



Leisure Linkers are passionate about making Croydon a more accessible and inclusive place to be. We want to help guide positive change for people with learning disabilities in Croydon. We hope to empower people to go out more, make informed choices and share experiences with others.

HERE IS WHAT WE HAVE TO SAY:

When we review a venue or gig we look at any barriers that could cause access to be a challenge. These barriers might be physical, such as a flight of steps or unclear signage. We also look at social barriers, like if a place makes you feel safe, welcome and accepted. It is all part of what really matters to develop our community and build a more inclusive social scene for everyone.
